Are you a BCCSA TCP that is Requalifying? Here is important information you need to know...



Do I have to take a 1-day course to renew my TCP certification?

Yes, as of January 1, 2019, the new 1-day TCP Requalification course is required. All TCPs needing to renew their TCP certification are required to take the new TCP Requalification course.

Requalification Eligibility

- You are eligible to requalify 6 months (180 days) prior to expiry
- You have 12 months after expiry to complete a requalification course, however you **cannot** work as a TCP while your certificate is expired
- You have a valid Authorization Code

Is there an alternative to the 1-day course?

Yes. TCPs have the option to retake the 2-Day TCP Course instead of the Requalification Course.

****TCP REQUALIFICATION COURSE**** (1-DAY)

Before you register for the 1-day TCP Requalification course you **must obtain a valid 5-digit Authorization Code**. To obtain your Authorization Code, please TEXT your 7-digit SN # to
